New Date

13 – 17 APRIL 2022 (Wednesday – Sunday) | 5 Days

Registration close Saturday, 12 March 2022

COVID-19 situation in many countries throughout Asia is recovering at a slower pace than expected. Many countries have imposed stricter quarantine rules for travellers returning to their home countries.

Based on this recent development, the APO organizers decided to postpone the tournament from 5 – 9 January to 13-17 April 2022 (Wed – Sun, 5 days)

We apologize for the inconvenience caused and hope that the new tournament date allows respective government to establish a VTL (Vaccinated Travel Lane) protocol or any other safe travel measures so to facilitate more participants to take part in the first-ever Asia Pickleball Open.

Phuket, Thailand remains open for travellers who are Vaccinated with PCR tested negative result. (<https://www.thaiembassy.com/travel-to-thailand/no-quarantine-phuket-sandbox-plan>) and we are committed to implement and adhere to Covid-19 Safe Measurement during the APO event.

Covid-19 is an endemic as some countries are classifying it. Most governments in Asia need to bring life back to the new norm (living under covid) as they may be unable to sustain the economy using its reserves. They will need to start business trading and opening up their borders, including tourism. We will have a clearer picture of government strategies in the next month or two.

1. ASIA PICKLEBALL OPEN (APO) - INFORMATION

This is an amazing opportunity to help showcase some of the best picklers in Asia, as well as players from international countries, and provide some timely relief to everyone dealing with COVID-19's challenges.

Phuket, the beautiful island in Thailand beckons you to enjoy the sun, beach, food, tourist attractions, and of course, Pickleball smorgasbord with 16 indoor courts at your disposal.

a. Organisers

APO is jointly organised by Thai Pickleball Association (THPA), Asia Federation of Pickleball (AFP) and Pickleball Global (PG).

THPA is an Associate member of AFP and PG owns Global Pickleball Ranking (GPR) software that provide player's scoring globally.

b. Tournament Location

Thanyapura @ Phuket, THAILAND

Approximately 16 mins (13KM) drive from Phuket International Airport (HKT).

c. Tournament Date & Time

13 – 17 April 2022 | Wednesday – Sunday (5 Days) | 09:00am – 18:00pm

Important

Please arrive 12 hours before your tournament day. This is because (1) you need to perform RT-PCR test upon arrival at the airport, (2) take the hotel's land transfer and (3) wait for 2 – 12 hours in the hotel room for the result. Only when you tested negative, you are free to move around without having to quarantine. Based on traveller's past experiences, they receive the result within 3-5 hours, but that's not guaranteed.

d. Tournament Courts

We will be converting 4 sheltered (not indoor) Tennis courts into 16 Pickleball courts. It is a hard surface court. We will treat this as an outdoor event.

e. Tournament Tier

This is Global Pickleball Ranking (GPR) Asia continent level, Tier 4 tournament.

a. Age

Age is calculated as per “year” of age, not based on month or day. Therefore, a player’s birth year 1972 means: 2022 – 1972 = 50 years old. (This player belongs to senior, 50+ age group)

b. Skill Levels

There are 4 skill levels under Global Pickleball Ranking (GPR).

In APO 2022, we created the tournament for Intermediate, Advanced and Open category.

c. Individual Games

There are 3 divisions (Singles, Doubles and Mixed Doubles).

d. Team Challenge (16 Teams)

- i. There is a limit entry of 14 Teams and 2 International Teams.
- ii. You can create 1 team once you have 5 players and serve as the team captain. You will be one of the players.
- iii. Player is NOT ALLOW to join more than one team.
- iv. Team captain can create your [memorable] Team’s name and select your team members. It is preferable but not compulsory to form a country team of the same nationality. Captain will pay the \$160 fee upfront and collect the amount back by divide it equally among the players. If there is any player request to join your team via registration platform, you can accept or reject them to join your team.

Each team should have a minimum of 8 players, with minimum of 2 women in the team. There is no cap limit of backup player. Men’s Doubles is COED (Men and women) competition format. The winning teams (Gold/Silver/Bronze) will receive max 10 medals per Team.

- v. International Team: If you can’t form a team, you can register into existing team or you can apply to join the International Team, but subject to first come basis and available vacancy. Team captain will confirm your request and you will receive a notification. Participation fee of \$20/player is payable to the team captain.



e. Payment & Refund policy on and before 12 March 2022

- i. Player will need to make payment during registration via Paypal online. YOU DO NOT NEED TO HAVE A PAYPAL ACCOUNT to pay for the registration. Paypal accepts both VISA and MASTER card payment.
- ii. You are allowed to cancel your registration at any time on and before 12 March 2022 by writing an email to the tournament director jan@pickleball.global for a full refund.

f. Lockdown Refund policy after 12 March 2022

- i. If Phuket is declared lockdown after 12 March 2022, we will postpone the event to another date in Q2 2022.
- ii. In the event that you can't join the new Q2 date, you can seek for full refund.
- iii. In the event that APO committee is unable to secure the Q2 tournament date, we will refund the full participation fees amount via the original payment channel.

- c. **Approved Ball:** We will be using **Franklin X-40 (Yellow)** outdoor approved tournament ball.
- d. **Rating:** You can refer to rating definition as a reference when converting to Skill Level (2b).

e. **Age Group**

Junior group (14U, 18U)	is allowed to challenge 18U, 19+ but not 50+ & 60+.
Adult group (19+)	not allowed to challenge the 14U, 18U, 50+ & 60+.
Senior group (50+, 60+)	is allowed to challenge 19+, 50+ but not 14U & 18U.

i. Merging groups

We will merge the following Age groups if it does not meet the minimum flight of Singles and Doubles.

- 14U and 18U
- 50+ and 60+

ii. Play up and not play down

- Novice player can participate in Intermediate/Advanced skill level.
- Intermediate can play up in Advanced/Open skill level
- Advanced player can participate in Open Level.
- But Open/Advanced Level must not play down to Advanced/Intermediate level respectively.

- f. The APO Tournament Directors reserve the rights to amend the rules and regulations or reschedule the fixtures of the tournament at any time as it deems fit. The decision on all such matters shall be final. Participants will be informed via the AFP and PG websites before the start of the tournament.
- g. The semis and finals will be held after the Round Robin and Elimination rounds. It will not be held on another day together with other divisions. The Prize presentation ceremony shall be held soon after the finals. All prize winners must be present personally at the ceremony in neat attire.



5. GAMES FORMAT

a. **Max # of Games:** Each day, a player can participate in only 1 division of a Skill level and Age group.

Example: A male player (Intermediate, 50+) can participate **max 4 divisions** in APO event.

- (1) Men's Singles: Intermediate | 50+
- (2) Men's Doubles: Open | 19+ (play up skill level and age group)
- (3) Mixed Doubles: Open | 50+ (play up skill level)
- (4) Team Challenge: Name: Lion Kings

PHUKET SANDBOX (PSB) - CONDITIONS & REQUIREMENTS in DETAILS

1. Country / Area of origin

- live or stay in the following country/area for at least 21 consecutive days before departure EXCEPT those who have Thai Certificate of Residence.
- check the full list here: **Appendix A.**

2. Vaccination

- received a full dose of vaccine against COVID-19 at least 14 days before departure the vaccine received must be approved by WHO or Thai FDA.
- List of approved vaccines
 - Pfizer/BioNTech (Comirnaty)
 - Moderna
 - AstraZeneca
 - Janssen
 - Sinovac
 - Sinopharm
 - Serum Institute of India (Covishield)

EXCEPTION - persons under the age of 18 travelling with their fully vaccinated legal parents are welcomed to PSB without vaccination (NB.: Please attach birth certificate for reference)

3. COVID-19 Test

- have a negative RT-PCR test result done **within 72 hours** before departure.
- have proof of paid reservation for COVID-19 tests in Phuket on Day 0*, 6 (or 7) and 12 (or 13) of your stay.
- *Day 0 = your arrival date in Phuket

4. Health Insurance (in English)

- Health insurance covering all medical expenses in relation to COVID-19 with a minimum coverage of **USD 100,000.**
- the insurance must cover the whole period of your stay in Thailand including after leaving Phuket for other parts of Thailand.
- The insurance must mention clearly that travelling to a risk area (travel advice color code: **orange** or **red** as indicated by the Dutch government) does not affect the scope and level of COVID-19 coverage.



5. Flight

- Option 1: **fly to Phuket directly** from outside of Thailand.
- Option 2: fly to Phuket on a flight that make a quick stopover in Bangkok (Suvarnabhumi International Airport - SVB/BKK or Don Mueang - DMK) without leaving the aircraft. please consult the airline of your choice.
- Connecting flight (international -> domestic) at SVB/BKK or DMK is not possible except in case of chartered flight to Phuket.

6. Accommodation

- You must travel from Phuket Airport to your SHA+ hotel by a **vehicle provided by the SHA+ hotel ONLY**.
- You are free to roam the island once the result of your first PCR test done on the date of your arrival is negative.
- You may stay in Phuket for **less than 14 nights** if you will directly leave Thailand from Phuket. You need to show a departure ticket that matches the end of your SHA+ hotel reservation when applying for a COE.

7. Tracking Application

- You are required to download **ThailandPlus** application and register before landing in Phuket.
- The application must be kept active at least throughout your 14 nights stay in Phuket.

8. Leaving Phuket

- You can fly out of Thailand directly from Phuket after 14 nights stay or even before.
- you can show negative results from 3 RT-PCR tests taken during your 14 nights in Phuket.
- you can show negative results from 2 RT-PCR tests taken during your 7 nights in Phuket.

10. HOTEL, RT-PCR TEST AND LAND TRANSFER PRICING

a. Hotel Booking

- You have to confirm a SHA+ hotel before arrival into Phuket. Your hotel booking should include 2-3 RT-PCR tests and local land transfer. (First PCR test is upon arrival at airport, and second test on 5th day at hotel and the last (if any), 72 hours before departure).
- Booking via email.** Inform them that you are from Asia Pickleball Open group to enjoy the discount and special rate.
- Book the Room + RT-PCR + 2-way Land Transfer as one package. Submit it during the application of Certificate of entry (COE).

b. Hotel Cancellation

For those players who book the APO package with the hotel, you are likely to get full refund at the end of the stay if you did not turn up. Please confirmed the cancellation policy with the hotel.

c. Air Ticket Cancellation

We believed that once Phuket is declared lockdown, you are able to discuss with your travel agency to postpone the air ticket to a new date or seek for a full or partial refund. Kindly refer to your travel booking T&C.

2. Do treat monks with the highest respect.
3. **Do dress properly** when visiting a temple, the royal court. no sleeveless shirts, shorts, or sandals are prohibited.
4. Do lower your body slightly when passing between or in front of people.

Thailand Don'ts

1. **Don't show disrespect** towards the Thai Royal Family. Violation of the monarchy whether in front or behind considered an offense under the Constitution.
2. Don't cross your legs when you are in the presence of a monk. This applies whether you are sitting on the floor or in a chair. Women should not touch or be too close to the monk.
3. Don't touch a Thai woman without consent. Despite the image portrayed in some bars and clubs, the majority of Thai women are conservative.
4. In Thailand, don't touch anyone's head. It's the most important part of the body.
5. Don't place your feet on the table while sitting, don't point to anything with your feet and don't touch anybody with your feet.
6. Public expressions of sexual feelings are not accepted in Thai culture.
7. The national flag is considered high. should not be taken for any action that is cynical.
